TROLLS: Save the Humans arrives at Filoli on June 7! Featuring six of Thomas Dambo's gigantic folklore-inspired troll sculptures built from reclaimed wood, the outdoor exhibition explores the intersection of folklore, poetry, and the human relationship to the natural environment.

Located in the Garden and along Filoli's trails, a walk to find the Trolls makes for a delightful adventure with family or a rejuvenating walk with friends. You'll meet Ronja Redeye, Basse Buller, Rosa Sunfinger, Ibbi Pip, Kamma Can, and Sofus Lotus. Each Troll has their own style and personality. Which one will be your favorite?

TROLLS: Save the Humans is a chapter of the bigger fairytale, Thomas Dambo's Trail of a Thousand Trolls. A group of six young Trolls have noticed that humans are disconnected from nature and have started harming the planet – their own home! Through activism, the goal of the tribe is to help the humans rediscover nature and inspire them to be good stewards of the earth.

Filoli is deeply committed to connecting people to the magic of

nature. This mission is what drew these magical creatures to the beloved estate. Found throughout Filoli's Natural Lands, the Trolls can be discovered over a beautiful onemile walking path winding through the redwoods. These playful, largerthan-life sculptures aren't only fun to discover—they carry an important message about taking care of our planet. Filoli is committed to both sustainability and natural lands management, and the Trolls will help introduce people to the six ecosystems and new trails on the property.

"I'm so happy my Trolls get to spend some time amongst the giant redwoods at Filoli," says Dambo. "I spent a day hiking in the forest, and it is a magical place where I know my Trolls will feel at home."


