Seasons happen in a pattern. The leaves of this Camperdown elm tree look different in every season. What season is it today?

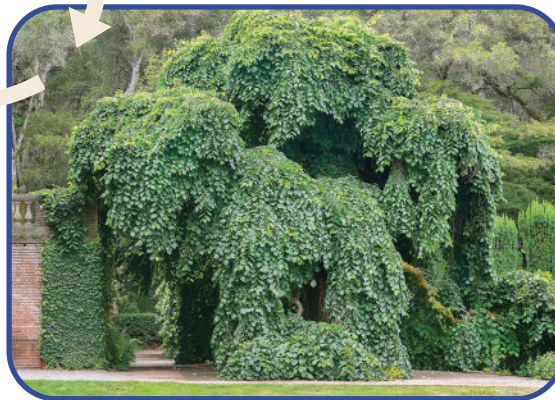

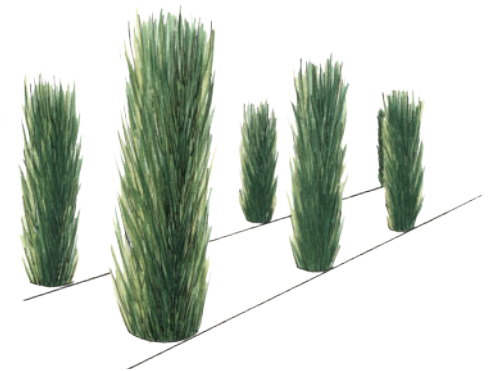

different types of flowers?

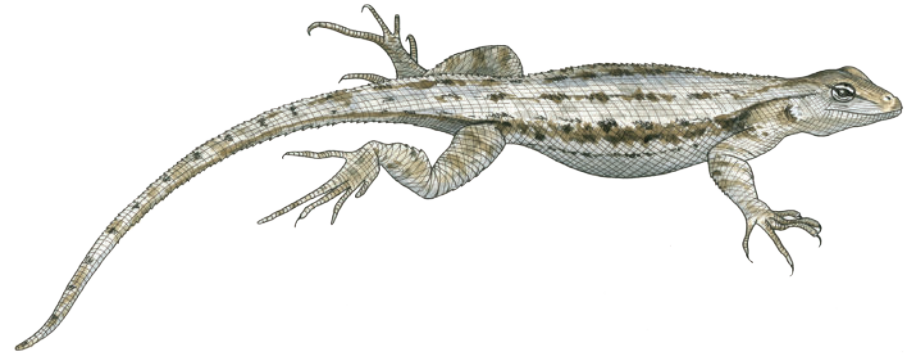
