**Materials List:**

Pad of drawing paper, Bristol Vellum 300, 11 x 14, or similar of good quality.

Kneaded eraser. Also **recommended -the Tombow Mono Round eraser for graphite drawing.**

Graphite drawing pencils, H or HB

I **highly** recommend the **Mitsubishi KH- 20 pencil sharpener** or the Rapesco 64 available on Amazon or a hand held sharpener.

Colored Pencils:

If you already have **good quality** colored pencils (Prismacolors, Lyra Rembrandt, Faber-Castell, Caran d’Ache Pablos or Luminance) bring them. Otherwise, it is best to buy the pencils we need **individually**.

If you already own watercolor pencils bring them.

### **Lunch and Dinner Options:**

### **Visitor Policy:**

- Only leashed service dogs are allowed on the grounds of Filoli. No other animals are permitted.
- Drinks may be brought into the Garden; however, only bottled water may be brought into the House.
- No smoking or open flame is allowed anywhere on the Filoli property.
- Filoli is a historic Garden. You may encounter natural hazards such as tree roots, uneven ground or gravel paths. Please be aware of your surroundings and watch your footing.
- For your safety, do not approach any wildlife.

### **Education Program Policy:**

- Students must wear a name tag provided by Filoli. Name tags give students access to the House, Garden, Estate Trail and the Clock Tower Shop during normal operating hours, excluding special events. Access is only on the day of the class.
- Many students require quiet to work at their best. Please be sensitive and courteous to your classmates and keep conversations to a minimum.
- Cancellations up to 2-weeks prior to a class are subject to a 25% cancellation fee. Cancellations less than 2-weeks prior to a class are non-refundable. Filoli does not issue credits for future classes.
