Visitor Policy:

- Only leashed service dogs are allowed on the grounds of Filoli. No other animals are permitted.
- Drinks may be brought into the garden, however, only bottled water may be brought into the house.
- No smoking or open flame is allowed anywhere on the Filoli property.
- Filoli is a historic garden. You may encounter natural hazards such as tree roots, uneven ground or gravel paths. Please be aware of your surroundings and watch your footing.
- For your safety, do not approach any wildlife.

Education Program Policy:

- Students must wear a name tag provided by Filoli. Name tags give students access to the House, Garden, and the Clocktower Shop during normal hours and only on the day they are attending class.
- Many students require quiet to work at their best, please be sensitive and courteous to your classmates, keeping conversations to a minimum.
- Cancellations up to 2-weeks prior to a class are subject to a 25% cancellation fee. Cancellations less than 2-weeks prior to a class are non-refundable. Filoli does not issue credits for future classes.
