### **Trees and Leaves in Pen and Ink**

**Prerequisite:** None. Pen and ink experience is helpful but not required.

**Hours of Credit:** 4

**Location:** This class is held in the **Roth Room** on the second floor of the historic House. Access to this classroom is by stairs only. #### **Materials List:**

This class has a minimal and simple approach to art materials. Please only bring what is on the supply list.

**Paper:** Sketch book, it is great to have a 9" x 12" with a spiral binding, however you can choose your size but not too small. Make sure that the paper can be used with ink, in other words, paper that is not too thin. I like Bee Paper Company, acid free, Super Deluxe Mixed Media.

A pad of Bristol paper- smooth or plate finish; Not the vellum finish. 9" x 12". You can buy a pad to share as you'll only need a few pages for the class. Still, it nice to have it in your paper collection.

**Pens:** Micron drawing pens, minimum of 2 pens. A .01 a must, and .03, .05 or a mix of sizes. You may use other brands like Staedtler or Graphix. Again In the .01, .03 and .05.

**Drawing Tools:** #2 drawing pencil, I like Pentel  
Eraser  
Small pencil sharpener

**Other:** Click Eraser  
A few Paper towels to rest your hand on your drawing. Not a roll please.

**Optional:** Bring your iPad, phone if you have one. We will take some photos. Don't worry about this if it's not your thing.

#### **Lunch and Dinner Options:**

- Picnic tables are available in front of the Visitor and Education Center. Filoli requests that students not eat in the House, but in the case of inclement weather students may eat in their classroom. Thank you for helping Filoli control pests and preserve the historic House.

**Visitor Policy:**

- Only leashed service dogs are allowed on the grounds of Filoli. No other animals are permitted.
- Drinks may be brought into the garden, however, only bottled water may be brought into the House.
- No smoking or open flame is allowed anywhere on the Filoli property.
- Filoli is a historic Garden. You may encounter natural hazards such as tree roots, uneven ground or gravel paths. Please be aware of your surroundings and watch your footing.
- For your safety, do not approach any wildlife.

**Education Program Policy:**

- Students must wear a name tag provided by Filoli. Name tags give students access to the House, Garden, Estate Trail, and the Clock Tower Shop during normal operating hours, excluding special events. Access is only on the day of the class.
- Many students require quiet to work at their best. Please be sensitive and courteous to your classmates and keep conversation to a minimum.
- Cancellations up to 2-weeks prior to a class are subject to a 25% cancellation fee. Cancellations less than 2-weeks prior to a class are non-refundable. Filoli does not issue credits for future classes.
